

WATER POLO WA COUNTRY

DEVELOPMENT FUNDS CRITERIA

To ease the financial burden on country centres, Water Polo WA Country Association (WPWACI) will continue to make funds available to all country Associations to help fund courses for the development of water polo in regional areas.

The funding criteria is as follows:

- Each centre can apply for funds up to a maximum value of **\$400** from WPWACI **two times** each financial year (July to June) to assist with running water polo development courses i.e. coaching, refereeing courses.
- Applications must be made in writing to wpwaci@gmail.com prior to the course being conducted.
- The minimum number of attendees per course is five (5).
- Once the application for funding has been approved, the country Association will need to invoice WPWACI for **\$400**.
- Invoices/receipts must be provided before reimbursements are made.
- Within two weeks, fund recipients will be required to submit to Hi EWPWACI a brief report on the course conducted (including nature of the session(s), number of attendees and photos)
- Further applications may be considered by the WPWACI Executive Committee if received in writing.

***Country Water Polo Associations are also encouraged to utilise alternative funding available from the Dept. of Sport and Rec and local shires/councils to assist with regional water polo development.*
