Introduction

The WPWAI Constitution outlines some basic parameters around which each Western Australian affiliated club/association is required to operate. The Constitution also provides direction for the clubs on the information which they are required to provide WPWAI on an annual basis.

This policy is to be utilised to ensure that WPWAI affiliated clubs/associations are aware of their obligations, and to minimise any areas of uncertainty.

Each club/association must apply for re-affiliation prior to the Annual General Meeting each year by completing and returning the current season affiliation agreement accompanied by the required documentation.

The club/associations latest Annual Report, including (if applicable) the audited annual accounts should accompany the application form. In addition, the club/association should provide a copy of their Constitution at a minimum every three years or when altered.

Details of the current club/association office bearers and a preferred club/association contact for the website, public enquiries etc will be forwarded to WPWAI by the 30th September each year. Changes of any club/association contact details should be forwarded to WPWAI as and when they occur.

Each club/association is also required to nominate a delegate to attend nominated club/association meetings or forums and/or submit reports of club activities to each meeting.

WPWAI Board meeting summary, club/association meeting agendas and minutes will be sent to all nominated club delegates who will be expected to keep their club and committee informed of WPWAI Board activities.
