1. An Advisory Group Member must exercise his or her powers and discharge his or her duties with a degree of care and diligence that a reasonable person would exercise in the circumstances
2. An Advisory Group Member must exercise his or her powers and discharge his or her duties in good faith in the best interests of the Association and for a proper purpose

3. An Advisory Group Member or former Advisory Group Member must not improperly use information obtained because he or she is an Advisory Group Member to:
 - a. gain an advantage for himself or herself or another person; or
 - b. cause detriment to the Association

4. An Advisory Group Member having any material personal interest in a matter being considered at an Advisory Group Meeting must:
 - a. as soon as he or she becomes aware of that interest, disclose the nature and extent of his or her interest to the Advisory Group
 - b. must not be present while the matter is being considered at the Advisory Group Meeting or vote on the matter.
 - c. This does not apply in respect of a material personal interest that:
 - i. exists only because the Advisory Group Member belongs to a class of persons for whose benefit the Association is established; or
 - ii. that the Advisory Group Member has in common with all, or a substantial proportion of, the members of the Association.

5. The Secretary must record every disclosure made by an Advisory Group Member in the minutes of the Advisory Group Meeting at which the disclosure is made.

6. No Advisory Group Member shall make any public statement or comment or cause to be published any words or article concerning the conduct of the Association unless the person is authorised by Water Polo WA Inc.
