MEETING SUMMARY –

STRATEGIC ITEMS FOR DECISION

- Finances were presented and approved by the Board for October. Note to be cautious of forecasted deficit and look at ways to increase revenue and decrease costs.
- A discussion on additional Directors resulted in a decision to target someone from a commercial background.

STRATEGIC ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

- The Board discussed and agreed to establish a working group for policy and process with focus groups to be established, noting consultation is the key to inform policy.
