Persons wishing to nominate for a manager position should be available to attend at least 2 training sessions per week.

Trials for the 15&U and 17&U age groups will be conducted over the weekend of 23/24 July and 30/31 July

The role will be responsible for areas such as:

- Communication requirements between team coach, parents, players, and WA Water Polo
- Coordinating the collection of payments from team members
- Correlation of team uniform order
- Event time liaison with all relevant third-party providers such as accommodation, vehicle and transport, communication etc
- Required team administration both prior to and throughout the event

- Event time liaison between event organisers and WA team

WPWA will be sending 2 Boys and 2 Girls 15&U teams, 2 Boys and 2 Girls 17&U team and 1 Men's and 1 Women's 19&U team. All teams will require a manager.

A State Team Managers Kit, airfare and accommodation in each competition venue will be available to selected persons to assist in fulfilling their role in the managers' position.

A Working with Children Check and brief Curriculum Vitae should accompany all applications or expressions of interest.
