1. The coach will conduct all training sessions in a professional manner where all athletes are engaged and treated equally, fairly and with understanding of individual circumstances.
2. The coach will develop the athletes' skills and techniques using their best knowledge and experience for the player's benefit.
3. The coach will prepare and submit to WPWA General Manager a training plan (including every session) for the period from the conclusion of the Selection Trials until the National State Team Championships.
4. It is a requirement that team coaches communicate regularly with the WPWA General Manager and other team coaches to discuss the training plans as well as the performances of athletes.
5. The coach agrees to accept all requirements set by Water Polo WA in their contract, as well as WPWA and WPA Codes of Conduct.
